

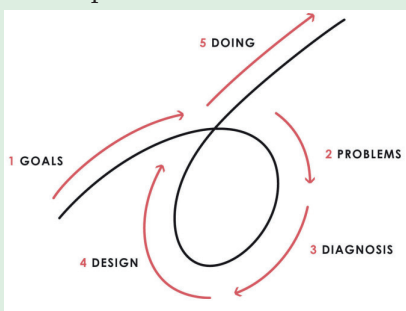

2. The Best Non-Agricultural Based

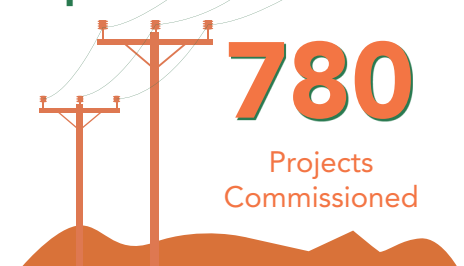
Statutory Board Stand.
