KEMP Projects in Turkana

REREC in partnership with the World Bank, is implementing projects aimed at transforming the lives of local communities through the provision of electricity in several rural counties. In Turkana County, the Kenya Electricity Modernization Project (KEMP) projects are being implemented at Kaeris and Kerio in Turkana North and Turkana Central Constituencies.

In compliance with the World Bank's safeguard policy guidelines on land acquisition, REREC held public Barazas at the two sites on 14th and 15th February 2022 respectively. The public participation exercise was to allow the communities to identify projects that REREC will implement compensation in exchange for the land they are donating for the mini-grid.

The two communities identified the provision of water for households and their livestock as their priority In Kaeris, the community proposed drilling of a new borehole or rehabilitation of the existing borehole and its equipment with a pump while installation of a new pump for the borehole at Kerio and rehabilitation of piping system were proposed.

The land acquisition process for the two projects is ongoing with National Land Commission (NLC) expected to issue allotment letters following the grant of no objection by the county government.
