Team to Evaluate **Performance Outcomes**



Public Pursuant the Service to Commission (Performance Management) Regulations, 2021 (L.N. 114 of 2021) and the provisions of Article 234 (2) of the constitution and section 92 of the Public Service Act, REREC has changed its management of the Performance Contract.


The new regulations require the establishment of two committees namely Performance Management Committee:- to guide the preparation of the Performance Contract (PC) and Employee Performance Management Committee:- to evaluate employee performance as per the key indicators set out in the PC.

Management Committee which is chaired by Ms. Beatrice Njuguna, Manager Administration, held its inaugural meeting this week formulate a work plan that will enable it to roll out its activities.

Employee Performance The mandate of the committee includes;

- i. Consideration and moderation of individual performance scores and making recommendations to authorized officers,
- Recommend to the authorized officers on rewards and sanctions to be imposed on an employee.
- iii. Recommend planned performance improvement for an employee.

Other members of the Committee are membership of the committee comprises the GM, Research, Strategy & Planning Managers, HRM, APE&A, Design, and Corporate Planning.





25 projects were commissioned in the week ending 25/02/2022, in various parts of the country.
